Be a Safe Rider. Remember, snowmobiling can be a high risk activity if you don't ride safely and responsibly. Being a Safe Rider and riding responsibly is a personal choice you make every time you operate a snowmobile. To make snowmobiling a safe recreational activity and reduce your own risk of injury or death, here are some of the safe riding behaviours that will help you make smart choices:

- Review and understand the safety guidelines for your sled.
- Stay on the marked OFSC trail.
- Keep to the right side of the trail.
- Slow down on all corners and when cresting hills.
- Avoid consuming alcohol while riding.
- Wear an approved snowmobile helmet.
- Stop before crossing roads and railway tracks.
- Use the approved snowmobile hand signals.
- Wear reflective clothing at night.
- Carry an emergency survival kit.

Legal provincial speed limits for snowmobiles

- 50 km/hr on trails
- 20 km/hr on highways with automobile speed limits of 50 km/hr or less
- 50 km/hr on highways with automobile speed limits of more than 50 km/hr

Brand new to Eastern Ontario, the Rails and Trails Ontario East Loop takes snowmobilers through rugged Lanark County and Ottawa Valley countryside, peppered with scenic small towns to warm up in. The loop is approximately 267 kms of beautiful wintry terrain on the Ottawa Valley Recreation Trail (OVRT), crisscrossing the Mississippi River in Carleton Place, Almonte and Pakenham, before heading north to the Ottawa Valley and then looping south down the K&P trail through lush Canadian Shield territory to Calabogie and Sharbot Lake. This one, two, or three-day tour will take you through Lanark County's snowmobile friendly communities, where local businesses are ready to warm you from the inside out. Travel through a winter wonderland, picture-perfect small towns and protected wildlife corridors along trails and former railbeds.
